Provider must be qualified and licensed in Washington State to provide MTM services. Provider must be a pharmacist or primary care provider with a National Provider Identification (NPI) number and a current license in Washington State.		
Provider must have a signed "Core Provider Agreement" (CPA) with the Health Care Authority (HCA).		
Pharmacist must practice in the CHPW pharmacy network.		
Provider must have access to the member's medical data and chart including laboratory results.		
Provider must be working with the member's primary care team to coordinate therapeutic goals, medication recommendations, and provide ongoing monitoring of implementation and results. Collaboration with the member's primary care team to coordinate therapeutic goals, medication recommendations, and provide ongoing monitoring of implementation and results is a requirement for reimbursement.		
Reimbursement rates for MTM services will be based on the HCA fee schedule.
